### **From the West:**

Take the A303 to Bullington Cross (the junction where the A303 meets the A34). \* Follow signs to Sutton Scotney. As you arrive in Sutton Scotney, you will come to a mini roundabout with a Texaco garage next to it. Turn L at this mini roundabout. Continue for approx 300 yds to small crossroads at brow of hill. Turn R towards Wonston. Go into village, over small bridge to T junction. Turn L towards Stoke Charity. Continue out of village and follow road for 2 miles into Stoke Charity. In Stoke Charity turn R towards Kings Worthy down a dead straight road heading due South out of the village. <> Continue for 1 ¼ miles until you see a sign on right hand side that says "Private Road-West Stoke Farm". Follow drive with white posts down into yard

### **From the North:**

Take A34 to Bullington Cross (the junction where the A303 meets the A34). Follow instructions from \* above

### **From the East:**

From M3, leave the motorway at junction 7 (2<sup>nd</sup> Basingstoke exit). At roundabout turn R towards Basingstoke, then 200 yds later turn L A33 towards Popham & Kings Worthy. Follow this road past The Rising Sun, and 2 miles later, The Wheatsheaf. The road then becomes a dual carriageway. 2 miles after end of dual carriageway, in 2<sup>nd</sup> dip turn R signposted Micheldever & Stoke Charity. Follow into village. In village, fork off to the L at large oak tree in village, while road swings around to the right. Follow for 2 miles into Stoke Charity. On entering village take 1<sup>st</sup> L towards Kings worthy and follow instructions in para 1 from the mark <> above

### **From the South:**

From M3 Northbound come off at Junction 9, and follow signs to A33 and A34, when on this dual carriageway make sure that you are in the right hand lane as carriageway divides. You want A33 towards Basingstoke. 1 mile after division. At brow of hill turn L down Lovedon Lane, signposted Stoke Charity. Follow road over railway and eventually turns into long straight road heading directly North. 2 miles after railway bridge you will see a white sign with black writing on the L which reads "Private Road – West Stoke Farm" Turn down here and follow drive with white posts down into yard.
