

Year 1 Curriculum Overview: Pirates and Explorers Autumn Term 2021

<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>Place value, Writing numerals and written numbers to 10 Counting in 2s and 5s Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10. Add and subtract 1-digit numbers to 10 including zero. Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes including rectangles, squares, circles, triangles, cuboids, pyramids and spheres.
